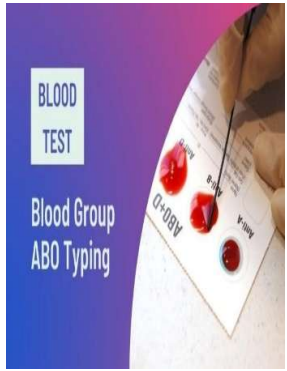

OPEN DAY



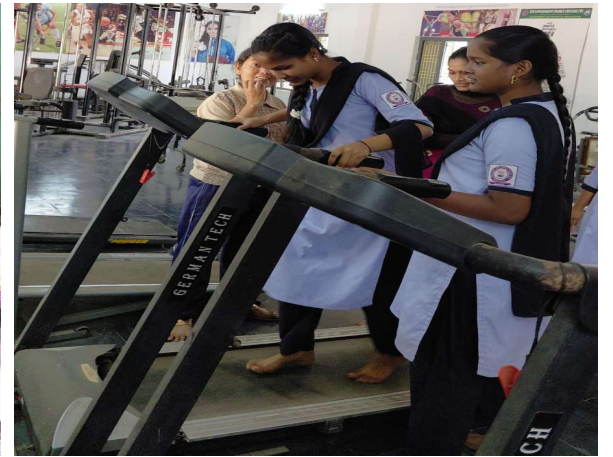

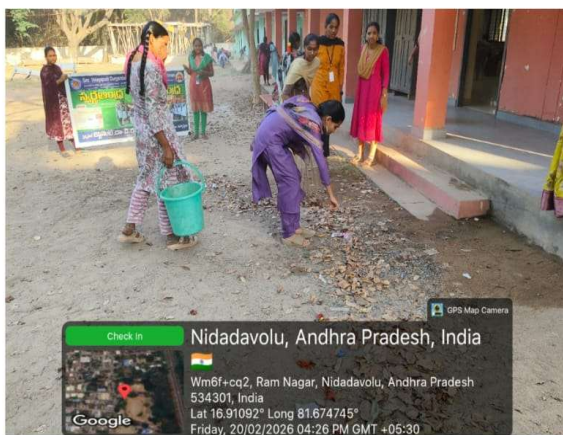
Awareness Rally on Zero Litter and Plastic Free Zone:

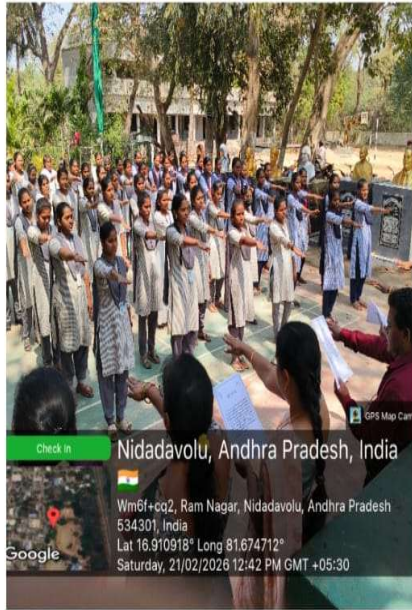

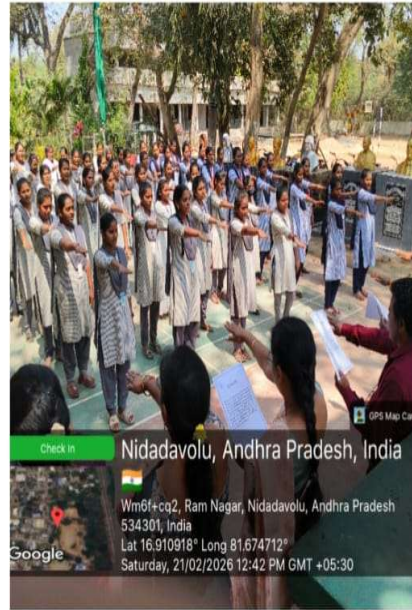

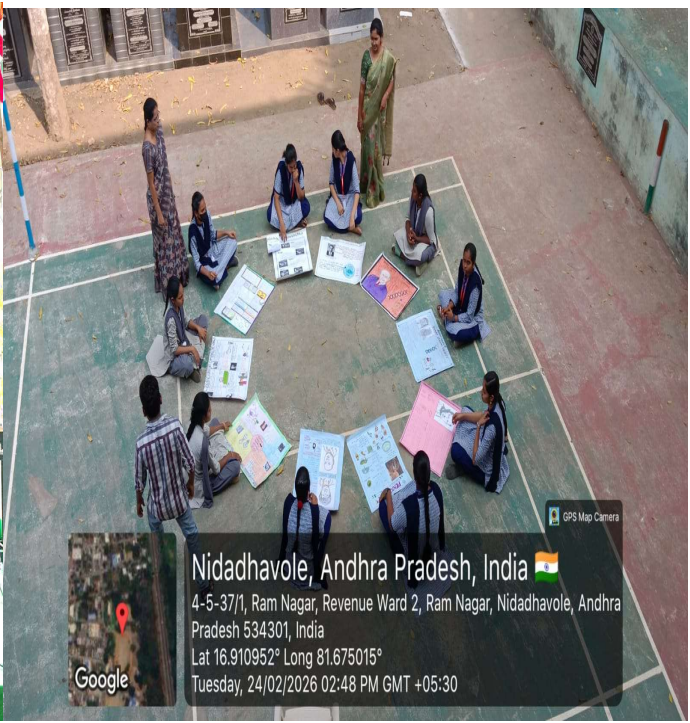

PEER TEACHING

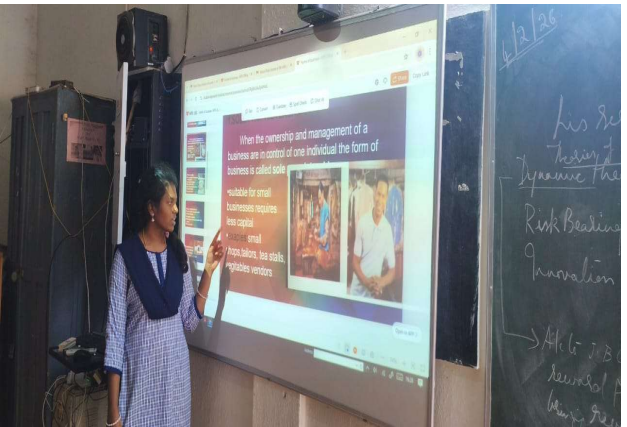

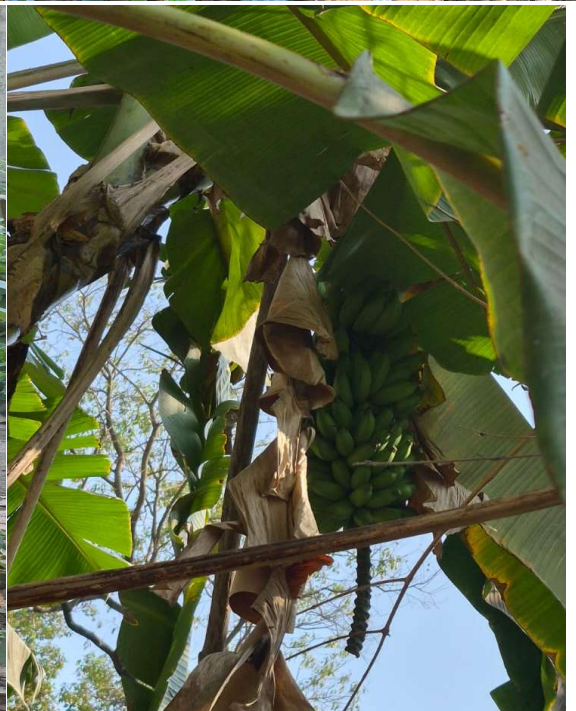


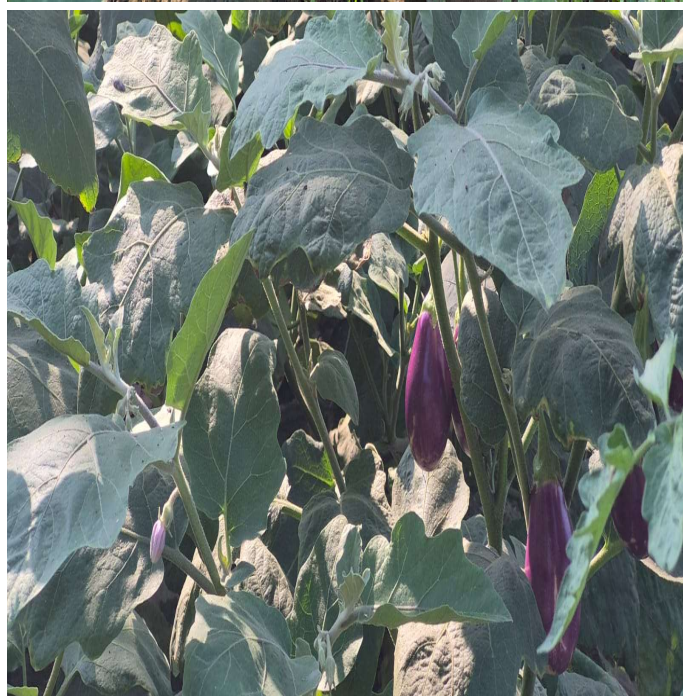
BEST PRACTICE – ORGANIC FARMING
