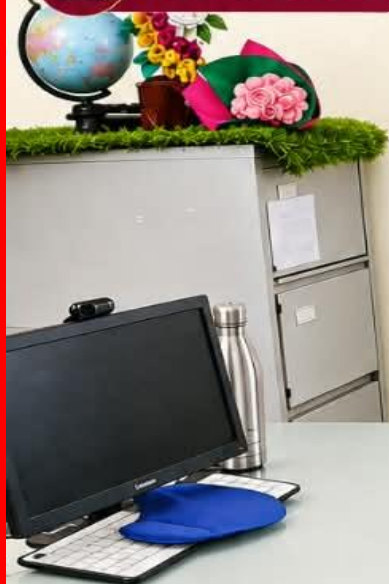

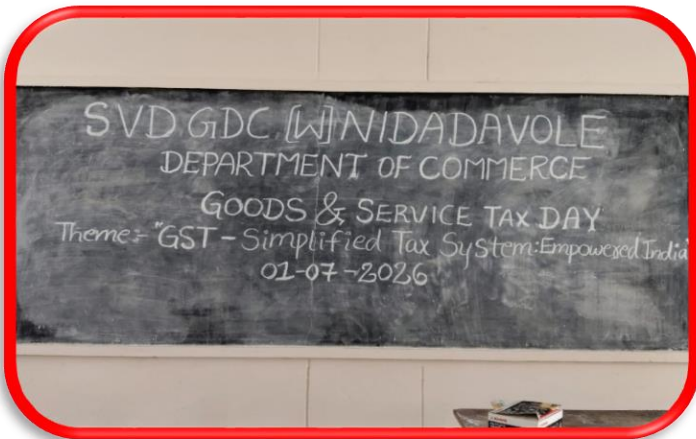

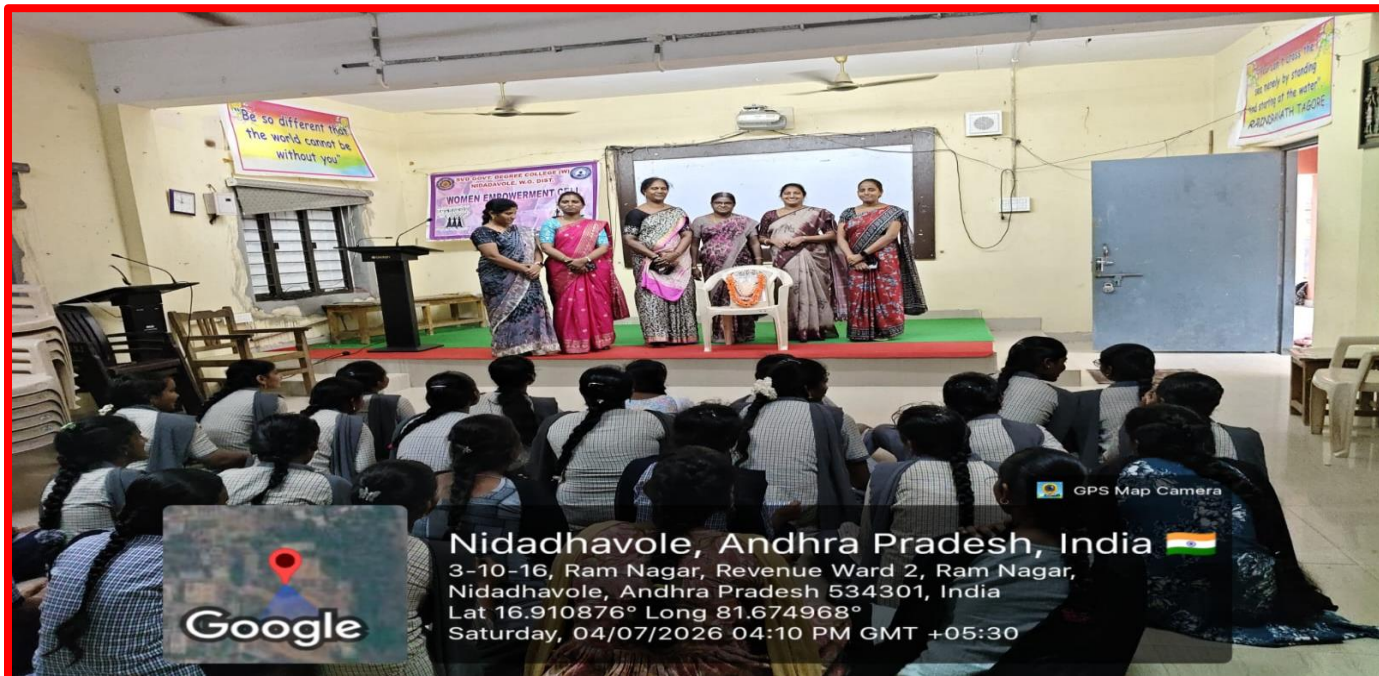


ALLURI SITA RAMA RAJU JAYANTHI

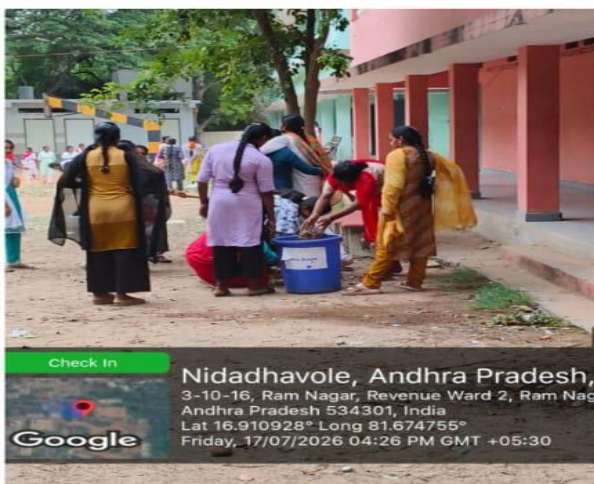

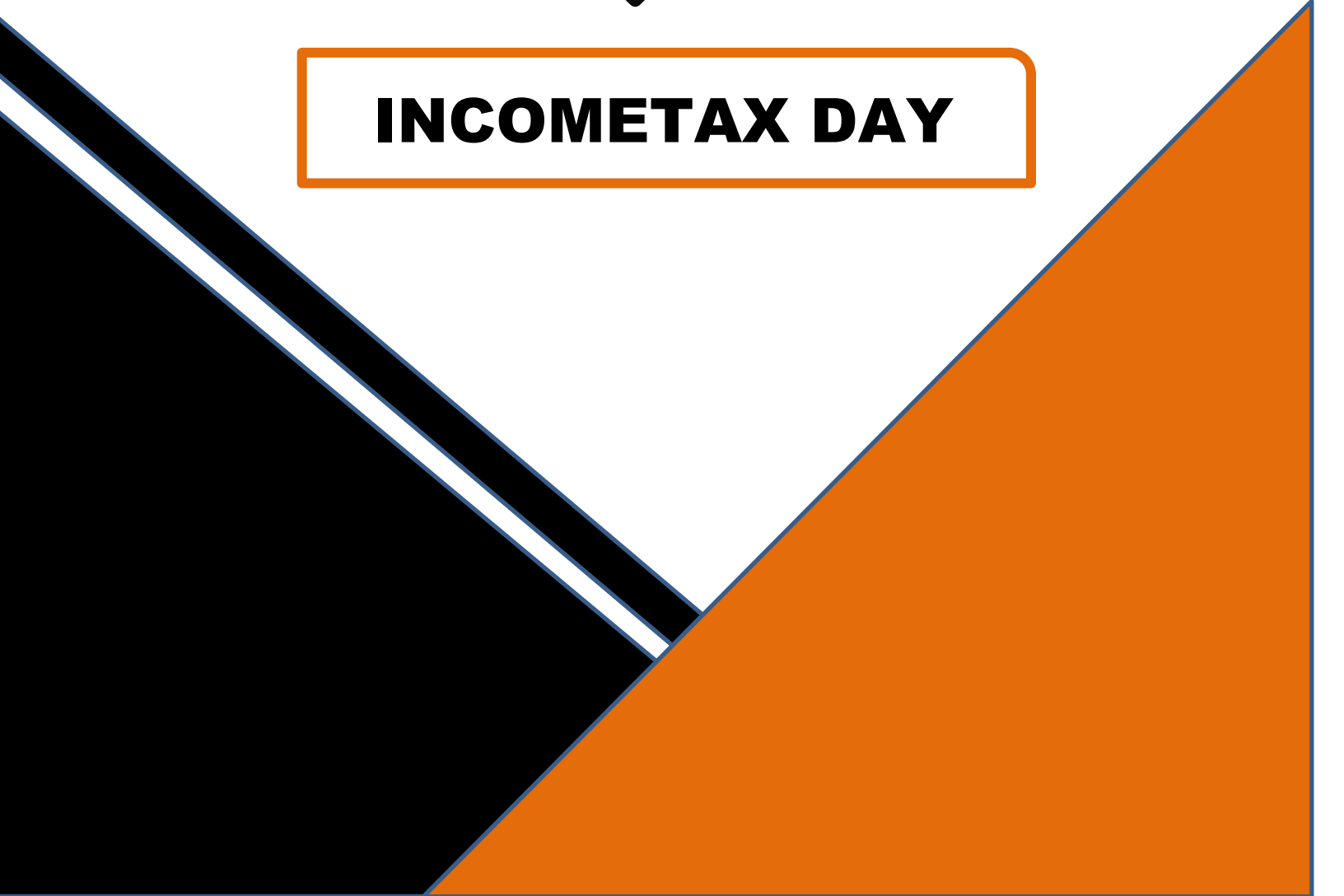
