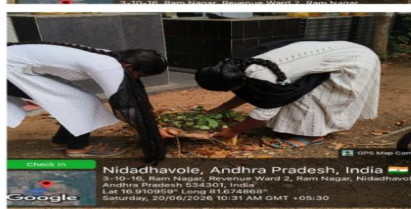
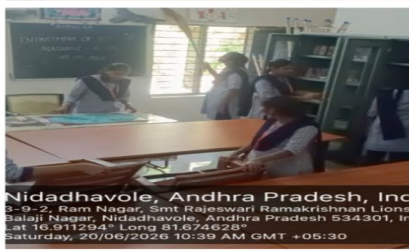
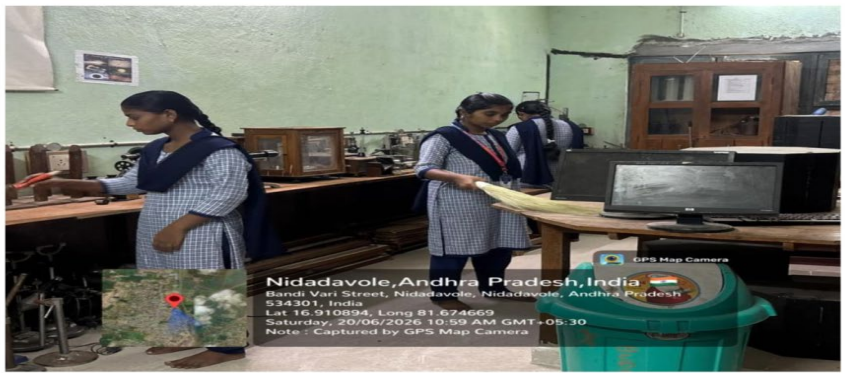
SWARNA ANDHRA – SWACHCH ANDHRA REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE, 2026

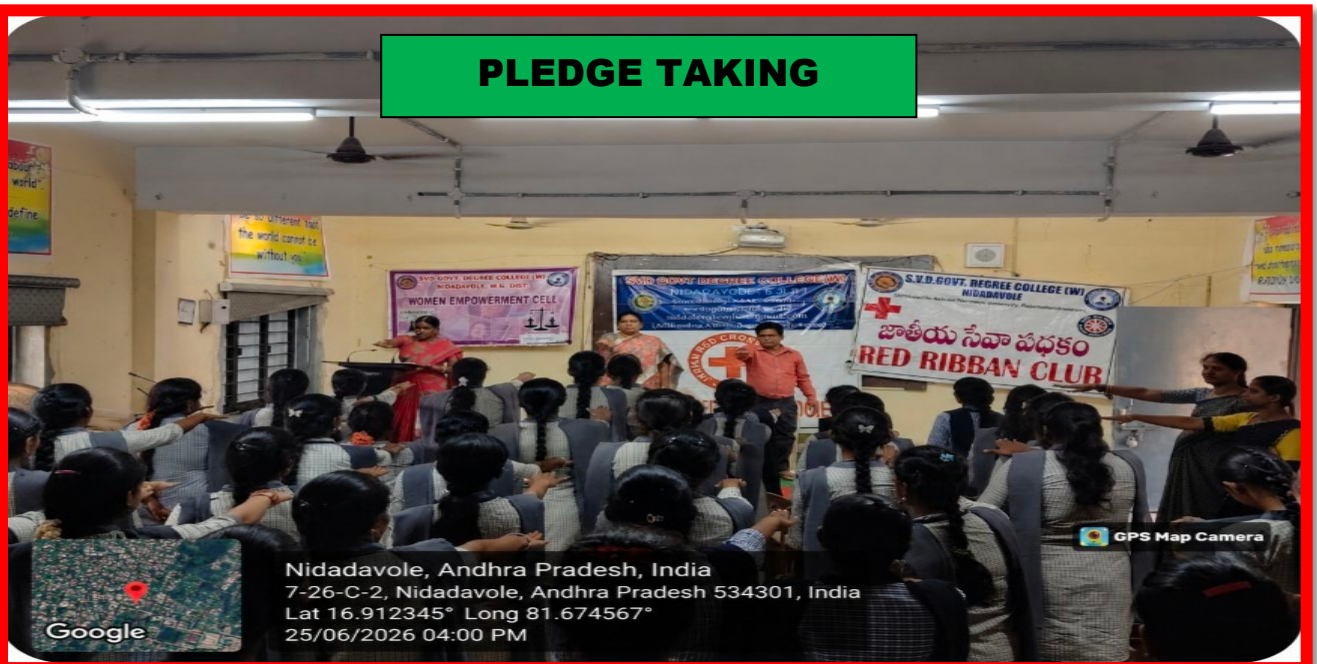
INAGURATION PLEDGE
