


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NATIONAL EDUCATION DAY

INTERNATIONAL MENS DAY



DT : 19-11-2025

The program highlighted the historical significance of adopting the Constitution in 1949.


Faculty members explained the core values of the Constitution such as justice, liberty, equality, and fraternity.

Students were informed about his pioneering work in fighting caste discrimination and promoting human rights.


Speakers emphasized his role in establishing schools for girls and marginalized communities.

The program motivated students to follow his ideals of equality, compassion, and social reform.


Students delivered speeches on his life and achievements, reflecting strong interest and awareness.

STUDENTS CENTERED LEARNING PROGRAMS




Students showed active participation in the seminars and peer teaching sessions conducted in our college. These activities helped students improve their presentation skills, confidence, and subject understanding.
