I wish you all the Best. Your valuable suggestions are always welcome.







Our college celebrated **United Nations Day** on 24th October to mark the establishment of the **United Nations** in 1945.

Vigilance Awareness Week – 2025


The SVD Government Degree College (Women), Nidadavole,


